After that, Grandma was flustered because she couldn't find Bella anywhere.


Then, when Grandma was dialing 999 for help, she suddenly saw the bushes move. She stopped dialing and rushed to the bushes.

After a few minutes of playing with Macy, her neighbour, Mrs Wong, saw her, and they started chatting with each other.


Suddenly, when they finished chatting, May found out that her daughter had gone already. May was oblivious to her daughter's absence because she was constantly playing on her phone.

May's mum said, 'You are very mischievous!'



Finally, May always goes to bed at nine o'clock. She won't sleep during the lesson again!




Today, David's alarm clock was not working. Suddenly, his mum came into his room and told him he would be late. Then, he packed his schoolbag as fast as a leopard.

Finally, he has learned to check whether his alarm clock works before going to bed. He felt lucky and relieved.








A Fun Day

Zoey Got Lost


Last Sunday, Zoey and her mom went to the park near their home. She got excited when she saw the swing; she asked, 'Mom, can I go on the swing?'

attention to Zoey.




In the afternoon, Grandma decided to take Kelly to the park. Kelly was excited. She rushed to the park as fast as a cheetah.
